The Kingfield Farmers' Market supports local farmers, promotes vibrant community, and effects important changes in food and agricultural policy at the regional, state, and national levels.

Wash your hands! pull out your aprons! and whip up your best to compete at the 2009 Kingfield Farmers Market Bake-off Events! New this season: celebrity judging panel, berry bake-off, People's Choice and Pro Choice awards, & your creations! Points are given for using ingredients from the market so shop before you chop! This season's Bake-off events:

Rhubarb	June 14	June 12
Berry	July 12	July 10
Corn	August 9	August 7
Apple	September 13	September 11
Pumpkin	October 11	October 9

Read below, then fill out a registration form to participate. Proceeds from the sale of your goodies at the bake-off events benefit the Kingfield Farmers Market, a 501(c)4 non-profit and a great community asset. Good Luck!

Your entry must be:

1. at the market by 10am on the day of the bake-off.
2. big enough to provide 60 small pieces.
3. submitted along with a complete list of the ingredients you have used.
4. accompanied by two appropriate serving utensils.
5. free of identifying marks/tags/etc that might allow patrons and judges to connect you to your entry. The market will provide a means to keep track of your entry on Bake-off Day.
6. Your entry must also be stable at ambient temperatures. Any entry that needs to be kept cool or hot to be safe and servable will not be allowed. Please refer to the Minnesota Department of Agriculture Pickle Bill Fact Sheet to help determine if your entry will meet health and safety requirements: <http://www.mda.state.mn.us/food/business/factsheets/picklebill.htm>

7. If it takes more than one dish to supply enough for 60 pieces, please tell us which one you would rather have us judge for appearance.
8. Use local ingredients.
9. Designate local ingredients and the producer name in your list of ingredients.
